The Bluffton Branch Library's Teen Advisory Board is sponsoring a **Teen Tournament**. The day's schedule:

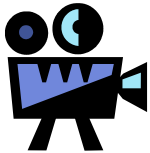
- **Teen Trivia** – Are you smarter than a 5<sup>th</sup> grader? **11:00 until 12:00**
